We're starting to work rapidly towards Elementary Camp, and we're so excited to start! Please remember that our camp day will go from 9am until 3pm each day.

ARRIVAL:

- Each day, the doors will unlock around 8:45am.
- On the first day, please come inside with your camper: I will give you a chance to check the pick-up list for accuracy and will have one final release for you to sign. If someone else drops your child off for you that morning (a friend or sibling, etc.), we'll send that document home.
- After the first day, you may drop off your camper and wait in your car until they've gone inside if you'd like.
- Your camper should bring:
 - A lunch.
 - Please avoid peanut butter if possible!
 - A water bottle.
 - Any medications they may need during the day, including an EpiPen or inhaler. You may leave any medications with me if needed, or your child may keep it on them if they're able to self-medicate.
 - No medication of any kind will be given to your children without contacting you.
 - \circ $\;$ Athletic shoes.
 - Open-toed shoes, sandals, Crocs, etc. are not great for movement onstage.

DISMISSAL:

- Doors will open a check out starting at 2:50pm each day.
- Whoever is picking your child up must come inside and check out with my staff.
- If someone new who isn't on our list is picking up your child, please let us know ahead of time via email.
- Please do your best to be on time each day. If you're running late, just send an email!

PERFORMANCES: Your camper is participating in CAMP A, which will perform at 6:30pm on June 7th. Tickets will be \$12 each. We'll have them on sale as soon camp begins!

CAMP COSTUME: Each camper will wear a camp t-shirt. The shirt will be provided. Please do not create an alternate costume for your camper. You may provide accessories and

dress your child however you'd like otherwise, but campers are required to wear their camp t-shirt for consistency.

AUDITIONS: Your camper will participate in an audition on the first day of camp. The Music Man KIDS does have some larger roles and some smaller ones, so this audition will help us find the perfect place for your camper. Fortunately, they do not need to prepare anything in advance for this audition! They should simply come ready to learn and engage. They'll be taught a line from the show and will sing a simple song, like Happy Birthday, and may also be taught something from the show. From there, the directors will cast the show at lunchtime and they'll set to work that afternoon.

Please note that, as described on the registration information, the deadline to request a refund for camp was May 1st. You may still withdraw your child from camp for any reason, but we will no longer be able to offer refunds for those circumstances. Please keep this particularly in mind on the first day of auditions; we will not be refunding camp tuitions for students who are disappointed because they do not get the role they desire. As your child gets excited for camp, please encourage them to look at all of the available roles and to try to be just as excited about all of them! There will only be one of each role, so please begin to prepare them to be excited about the show regardless of their role!

OTHER NOTES:

- COSTUMES: Your child's costume for Elementary Camp will be their camp t-shirt (which they'll receive on Friday) and whatever bottoms they choose to wear.
- We will not be filming any of our camp productions this summer. Unfortunately, we are not contracted to permit such.
