### **The Schedule**

Auditions will be held on Saturday, June 6th from 9:00-noon at the Grand Theatre. Campers need to plan to be there for the entire casting day. Plan to receive an email about casting before camp begins the following Monday.

All campers will receive a role in the show; no cuts will be made. **We will not be offering refunds for campers who are not pleased with their role, so please prepare your camper ahead of time for the reality of the audition process!**

If your camper has a role they'd like to play, encourage them to prepare and put themselves forward. That said, also encourage them to be excited about anything in this show. There are a lot of opportunities in this show!

Camp days run Monday through Friday from 9:00-4:00 each day. Camp begins June 8<sup>th</sup>.

On Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup>, the camp day will end at 3:30pm to give campers extra time to rest before their call time at 5:30pm.

Shows will be on Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m. Camper call time for Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup> will be 5pm.

### **Audition and Casting Information**

You do not need to send your camper with a lunch – we won't take a lunch break on audition day.

For auditions, the only thing you need to prepare is part of a song to sing for us. Please consider the show we are doing and look for something in a similar style so we can really see how you will handle this type of music. **Please do not sing a song from Camp Rock.** Be prepared to sing the equivalent of about a verse and a chorus of your song (or a 32-bar cut if you have that prepared) and please perform it memorized.

You must bring a recorded accompaniment or plan to sing a cappella. If you do bring recorded accompaniment on your phone, we will plug it in with an aux cable or use a Bluetooth speaker.

We want to hear you sing your song in character – make some strong choices about who is singing and why you are saying these words at this time. We do not need to hear you simply mimic another singer – do it your way and make us feel something real. Your vocal audition will be a huge portion of how we make casting decisions – make it special.

Please come to auditions (and to each day of rehearsal) dressed so you can move for dance. You need to wear clothes you can move in easily – not leotards. Please do not plan to dance in flip-flops or sandals – open-toed shoes are not allowed onstage. Bring or wear sneakers – jazz sneakers are fine – or ballet shoes, or other shoes that will support your foot as you dance. You do not need to go out and buy dance shoes for the audition. You will not be allowed to go barefoot in the theatre at any time.

Athletic wear is acceptable for camp, but please make sure that you're fully covered. If you could not wear it for gym class at school, please don't wear it to camp!

### **Security**

No visitors are allowed in the theatre during camp. Only theatre employees, camp staff, and campers will be allowed in the building, and the doors will remain locked otherwise. Parents cannot watch auditions or hang out during rehearsal days.

### **Camp Arrival**

Campers will check in at a table in the front lobby of the Grand Theatre. Parents do not need to accompany them.

### **Camp Departure**

Campers can sign themselves out as long as they know who is picking them up and have identified them waiting in the parking lot.

### **Lunch**

Campers will be allowed to eat lunch out in the community if given parent permission. We'll obtain that permission prior to the first day of camp (after auditions). We do not go out into the community for lunch on Mondays as most restaurants are closed.

### **Absences**

It is very important to be on time and present at every rehearsal. Every actor is important! Please try to avoid scheduling appointments during these two weeks. If you have an unavoidable appointment and must be out, please arrange to get back to rehearsal as soon as possible. If you are running late or must be out due to an emergency, please let us know as soon as possible.

## **Medications/Illness**

We will only provide medication to your camper with explicit permission. They may keep medication on them as needed; please let us know if there is something they'll be responsible for taking themselves that you'd like us to help monitor.

Please keep your camper at home if they have exhibited (or come into contact with anyone exhibiting) any of the following: a temperature over 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, other respiratory symptoms, or at least two of the following symptoms: chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
