

We're excited to have your camper join us for Primary Camp at the end of June. Below, please find some additional details as you prepare for what will be a fantastic week!

Our camp day will go from 9am until noon each day; please pre-emptively arrange your child's pick up and drop off. We have camp from Monday, 6/22 until Friday, 6/26 with your show that evening at 6pm.

#### **ARRIVAL:**

- Each day, the doors will unlock around 8:45am.
- On the first day, please come inside with your camper: I will give you a chance to check the pick-up list for accuracy.
- Your camper should bring:
  - A snack.
  - A water bottle.
  - Any medications they may need during the day, including an EpiPen or inhaler. You may leave any medications with me if needed, or your child may keep it on them if they're able to self-medicate.
    - No medication of any kind will be given to your children without contacting you.
  - Athletic shoes.
    - Open-toed shoes, sandals, Crocs, etc. are not great for movement onstage.

**Please note: as mentioned at registration, we ask that parents/guardians drop off their camper each morning. It may be tempting to want to stay until they get acclimated, but we ask that you refrain from doing so. If one parent stays, it can create a chain reaction that makes it difficult for anyone to get acclimated. We promise to keep your child safe!**

#### **DISMISSAL:**

- Doors will open for check out at 11:50am.
- Whoever is picking your child up must come inside and check out with my staff.
- If someone new who isn't on our list is picking up your child, please let us know ahead of time via email.

- Please do your best to be on time each day. If you're running late, just send an email!

**PERFORMANCES:** Your camper will perform at 6pm on Friday, June 26<sup>th</sup>. Tickets will go on sale on 6/22!

**CAMP COSTUME:** Each camper will wear a camp t-shirt. The shirt will be provided. Please do not create an alternate costume for your camper. You may provide accessories and dress your child however you'd like otherwise, but campers are required to wear their camp t-shirt for consistency.
